Fretted Instruments - Ashworth

- 8826** Guitar, 'Budget Bug', medium output fits anywhere on to instrument
- 8821** Guitar, as above, high output also suitable for mandolin, bouzouki etc
- 8821J** As above, with endpin jack socket
- 8822** Guitar Micro Strip, fits under standard width bridge saddle
- 8823** Guitar/Mandolin, floating bridge fitting
- 8828** Banjo strip, fits on head

Bowed Instruments - Ashworth

- 8811** Violin, fits anywhere on body of instrument
- 8811B** As above, bridge fitting
- 8812** Violin electric bridge, for solid body instruments
- 8831** Double Bass/Cello, fits anywhere on body of instrument
- 8842** Double Bass, fits on bridge
- 8842P** As above, twin transducers

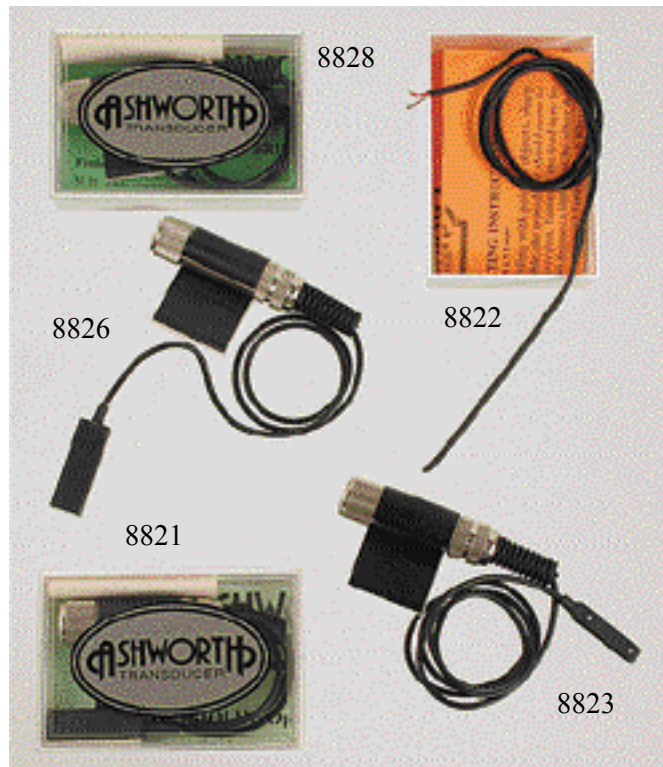
