The history of the Franz Sandner workshop, in Germany, stretches back over several generations of craftsmen. The Sandner name has a reputation for high quality student and orchestral violins, violas and cellos. All instruments are made under the supervision of the Sandner family.

antique 'distressed' finish, spirit varnish
4/4 size only

- 1841** Viola, selected tonewoods
15", 15½", 16" sizes
- 1842** Viola, selected tonewoods,
attractive shaded finish, spirit
varnish

- 1846** Viola, selected tonewoods,

varnish, a fine instrument

- 1599** Narrow grain spruce table,
selected flamed back, ribs and
neck, golden brown varnish
- 1878** Selected close grain spruce
table, well flamed back, ribs
and neck, amber gold varnish.
